
FTI Pilot – How does it work?

What type of activities are supported?

- Business model validation
- Advanced and specific research and development activities
- Standard setting and advanced performance testing / piloting / demonstration activities
- Validation of solutions in real working conditions / certification

Who can participate?

Consortia of a limited size, max 5 partners (from EU member states and associated countries)
 ... but can be composed of partners from any type of legal activity;

Supporting highly innovative SMEs with a clear commercial ambition & a potential for high growth and internationalization

SME Instrument – How does it work

Phase 1

Concept & Feasibility assessment

Phase 2

Demonstration, Market Replication, R&D

Phase 3

Commercialization

- **50.000** in EU funding
- Feasibility study
- Initial **10 page business proposal** to be drafted
- 6 months in duration

- Between 0.5 and 2.5M of EU funding
- Develop project through innovation strategy
- Draft a more developed
 30 pages business plan
- 1-2 years in duration

- No stand-alone phase
- No direct funding
- Business coaching
- Facilitate access to risk finance
- Additional support & networking opportunities
- SMEs "Business club"

- Improved in-situ components of the GEOSS and Copernicus programmes



- Topic identifier <u>SC5-19-2017</u>
- Types of action: CSA Coordination and support action
- Deadline: 07 March 2017
- To maximise the benefits for European citizens of the Earth observation infrastructure by developing innovative services that support more sustainable production and consumption patterns and resilient societies.
- To develop innovative solutions to complete the in-situ component of GEOSS and Copernicus and make available an operational information system, enabling the sharing and full, open and unrestricted access to validated Earth observation datasets
- Engaging with the private sector to leverage emerging technologies and develop services.

- Addressing the adaption of big data technologies to Copernicus user scenarios...
- Solving EO big data challenges by developing tools for data lifecycle;
- Participation of industry, particularly SMEs, is encouraged



Downstream applications

- Topic identifier <u>EO-1-2017</u>
- Deadline: 1 March 2017



- Addressing a variety of applications stemming from the use of EO & its smart integration with other related technologies
- Outcome: a commercial service platform, sustained by a production process capable to deliver to the user a marketable product
- Corresponding validations and customizations are to be undertaken, and the business case of for the applications is to be demonstrated
- The choice of EO application is left to the proposer
